


## **COVID-19 vaccines:**

## Booking a vaccination





The NHS has an online service to book a coronavirus (COVID-19) vaccination.



get the 2<sup>nd</sup> dose 11 to 12 weeks after getting your 1<sup>st</sup> dose.



For a vaccination, you will need to:



Who can use this service?



have 2 doses of the coronavirus vaccination at 2 different appointments



You can only use this service if you have got a letter inviting you to book your vaccination appointments.



book both appointments at the same time



The vaccination is currently being offered to people aged 80 or over.



Letters are being sent out every week – you might not get your letter straight away.



What happens at your appointment?



You will also need to be registered with a GP surgery in England. You can register with a GP if you do not have one by clicking here: <a href="https://bit.ly/38qljEg">https://bit.ly/38qljEg</a>



Your appointment should take 30 to 45 minutes.



You can use this service for someone else.



This will include:



The list of people who can get a COVID-19 vaccine will change as more people are offered it over the next few weeks and months.



being checked in using your booking reference numbers



answering questions about your medical history



You will be asked for your NHS number.



having the vaccine injected.



This is a 10 digit number you can find on any letter the NHS has sent you.

For example, 585 644 8675.



You will be asked to wait for around 15 minutes after having the vaccination.

This is just in case you have a reaction to the vaccine.



If you do not know your NHS number you can still book an appointment.
