

# #YourVoiceMatters

Between 31 August and 2 November IG did the Your Voice Matters Survey, workshops and roadshow finding out what is important to people with learning disabilities and / or autism for the Glos Joint Strategic Analysis.

We spoke to hundreds of people with learning disabilities and /or autism of all ages and the people who support them.

What people told us is now being written up in a report which should be ready by May 2019.

IG will use the findings from our report to inform some of our future projects and hope it provides information for other organisations when they are commissioning new services.

We have already listened to what people said about hate crime and are writing a bid to see if we can get funding to do some work about this.
