User Led Quality Checks

Led by disabled people, for disabled people.



- Experts by Experience lead the Quality Check
- We give people facing disabling barriers a voice
- We identify things that could be better and support providers to improve

Where do we do Quality Checks? Residential homes, hospitals, supported living, domiciliary care.



What happens on a Quality Check:

- Meet people living with a disability, autism or mental ill health
- Find out what is good about their care and support



- Think about if they can have better support
- Ask staff about the people they support



- Talk to the Manager
- Tell the Provider things they are doing well
- Tell everyone what they could do better
- Sometimes we do a Follow Up Visit



How we have helped



A person had their Annual Health Check booked after speaking to us





An individual set their own goals and chose which ones to do each day





A home helped someone buy a fish tank for their bedroom which was calming





Staff were calling people 'grumpy', the Manager spoke to the staff and they stopped



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
